## 4th Project Meeting

The 4<sup>th</sup> project meeting will take place in Los Santos de Maimona on 27-28<sup>th</sup> April, 2015.

Los Santos de Maimona is a town and municipality in the province of Badajoz, Extremadura, Spain. It is located between the San Jorge, San Cristóbal and Cabrera mountain ranges, in an area of rolling hills, on the Vía de la Plata (Silver Route) from Mérida to Seville.

Farming activity still plays an important role in the economy of Extremadura. The regional agricultural sector is highly diversified, with a variety of agricultural areas, landscapes and productive orientations (maize, rice, cereals, vegetables, fruit, olive, vine, tomato, paprika, tobacco, cattle, pigs, sheep...).

The production of berries in Extremadura is influenced by weather conditions, which until now has restricted the crop to the mountainous areas in the north of the region. Among the berries the most cultivated are raspberries, followed by blueberries/cranberries, blackberries and redcurrants. The number of producers is around 300; most of them are very small.

Extremadura has a great potential for the production of high quality organic products. The total surface dedicated to the production of organic foods in Extremadura has gone from 64,000 hectares in 2006 to about 95,000 hectares in 2010, which represents a 30% increase in this time period!

We are looking forward to meet the people that grow and market superfoods in Los Santos de Maimona/ Extremadura and discuss how SmartFarmer could contribute to the development of this sector.
